- II. Committee and Chair Reports

The balance remaining after benefits will be divided equally among all 2010-2011 staff (including instructional and non-instructional)

Staff members will receive $\$520 \times 103 = \$53,660$ (estimated amount)

New instructional personnel to Park Trails \$50.00 ACE Gift card (3)

Amount will be paid out to staff of 2010-2011 that worked 1 day more than half of their contract in the 2010-2011 school year. Staff that worked a percentage of fulltime will be paid an amount proportionate to their contract percentage.

Amount remaining after instructional and non-instructional awards are paid will be returned to the school to be spent on supplies to benefit the entire school.
